Report of Benefit Dance for Howard Hospital held September 9, 2006

The largest number of dancers -70- (both Scottish Country and Old Time Dancers) responded to our invitation with 62 actually present. They supported this Benefit not only by their presence but by their monetary donations and in their strong support of the Silent Auction.

Dr. Paul Thistle, Director of Howard Hospital and his family joined us for the evening. He spoke of his work there and noted that the hospital is the only medical facility serving a population of 260,000 people. To quote Paul "The huge demand for HIV care is high but the costs are low, at \$1.00 per day. The road to recovery for patients on antiretrovirals can be so impressive that people have called it the Lazarus effect". He said that antiretroviral drugs make a difference in the lives of those able to take them if only for 1, 2 or 3 months. Now remember your personal donation(s) and think about the lives you have changed.

So many people made this Benefit the most successful of all those we have organized. A number of supporters could not be at the Benefit but generously supported it by their donations both in cheques and items for the Silent Auction.

We would like to extend heart warming thanks to everyone but especially Anita Mathur and Una Lennam who so capably ran the auction, Diane Rankin and Sally McAuley who organized the refreshments, and Irene Feir and Gordon Simpson who received and kept records of all donations. A copy was sent to Paul to

take with him to Howard Hospital. Our thanks also go to our teachers, Willie McDermott-Bruce and Bob Anderson. Without all your support this Benefit would not have been such a success!
