Thank you letter from Lorraine Irving

Dear Friends, Thank you for the kind and generous support that you are giving to the children in the Chiweshi area around Howard Hospital. The dance was a great success and I hope you all enjoyed it. Thank you to Pat for organizing the dance, also the teachers and everyone else who helped. Donations to VIDEA were \$2398.00 and this will pay school fees and all donors will receive a tax receipt from VIDEA, please let me know if you do not get a receipt. Total cash from the entrance and sale was \$810.10, this will be used to buy goats for orphans.

The problems at Howard have not been solved and the hospital is barely functioning. The trial of the staff has been delayed again until later this month. Paul is in Harare and is not working.

Some good news. Lovemore has a cell phone and I was able to talk to him and he will take all school fees with Doug Funk {Solon Foundation}. This morning I received an email from Mr Moyo, the headmaster at Musarara Sec School and Lovemore and Doug were at his school Oct 9. We will not receive messages like this from other schools as they do not have access to email.

If any one is interested about the onset of the problem at Howard you can go to Salvation Army web site and read a letter by Allan Bacon. There is an investigating team in Zim now, from Sal Army in Canada and UK.

Thank you very much for your kind support now and in the past.

Letter to Mr Moyo, the headmaster at Musarara Sec School from Lorraine

Dear Mr Moyo, With all the sad changes at Howard I am unable to return there this month as planned. I am asking for your assistance with paying school fees at your Primary and Secondary schools and Maori primary. The amount will be similar to last year. Doug Funk is with the Solon Foundation and is familiar with the area and he has agreed to bring the donations for fees. He would be able to be at your school Oct 8 or Oct 9 in the afternoon. Would you kindly send me the amounts for the fees for the same number of children as last year, that is for all three schools. Receipts would be needed as always. I am unable to communicate with Lovemore Katumbe, but if you are able to contact him, he always helped a great deal as you know. Also could you tell me the name of the Sec school where students from Maori go?

It was always a pleasure to see you and visit your school, and I hope in future I may be able to return. With best wishes to you and your family and school staff.

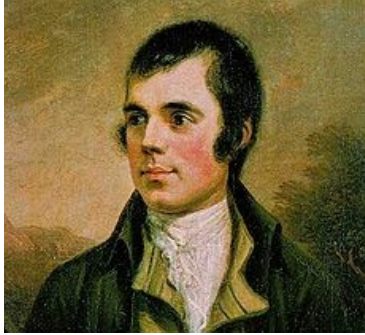
