A BASIC dancer is a less experienced dancer who would like to learn or polish the following formations:

Setting (S & R/J)	Travelling	Casting	Step Up/Down
Set & Cast	Crossing	Turning	Rights and Lefts
Cross & Cast	Cross Down	Dance or lead down	
Hands Across	Hands Round		Allemande
Promenade	Chase	Figure of Eight	Reels of 3 or 4

An INTERMEDIATE dancer is comfortable with the basic formations above and ready to learn or polish the following:

Inveran Reels	Set to and Turn Corners	Set & Link	Ladies/Mens Chains
Tandem Reels	Turn Corner-Partner	Set & Rotate	The Knot
Crossover Reels	Corner Pass & Turn	Double Triangles	Petronella
Diagonal Reels of 4	Set to Corners & Partner	Grand Chain	Square Poussette
